

. They are an extension of our main work located in the PRIMARY BOUNDARY (ST KILDA TRIANGLE). These mini SOLAR TREES respect the surrounding infrastructure (lighting, power lines, street trees, etc.). They fit into the urban setting and can be arranged next to bus shelters so that users can enjoy their shade. They are important tools for conveying a message of eco-responsibility to the people.



Our building for ST KILDA TRIANGLE is a sculptural work inspired by nature: trees. Our proposal is inspired by biomimicry. It represents several trees whose leaves are other than large solar panels. These panels are inspired by solar ovens.
