



Tanderrum is the aboriginal ceremony which is used to welcome foreigners and allow them access to land and resources. Triderrum takes aspects of the traditional ceremony and combines them with modern material and culture to create a piece of art which not only produces energy but also provides a space for relaxation, socialization, and interest. The arrangement of organic photovoltaic film across the Triangle site is comprised of five nodes. These nodes, which represent the five clans of the Kulin Nation, resemble and function similarly to the Tanderrum ceremonial space. Intermediary members connect the five nodes and symbolize the connection between the five clans.
