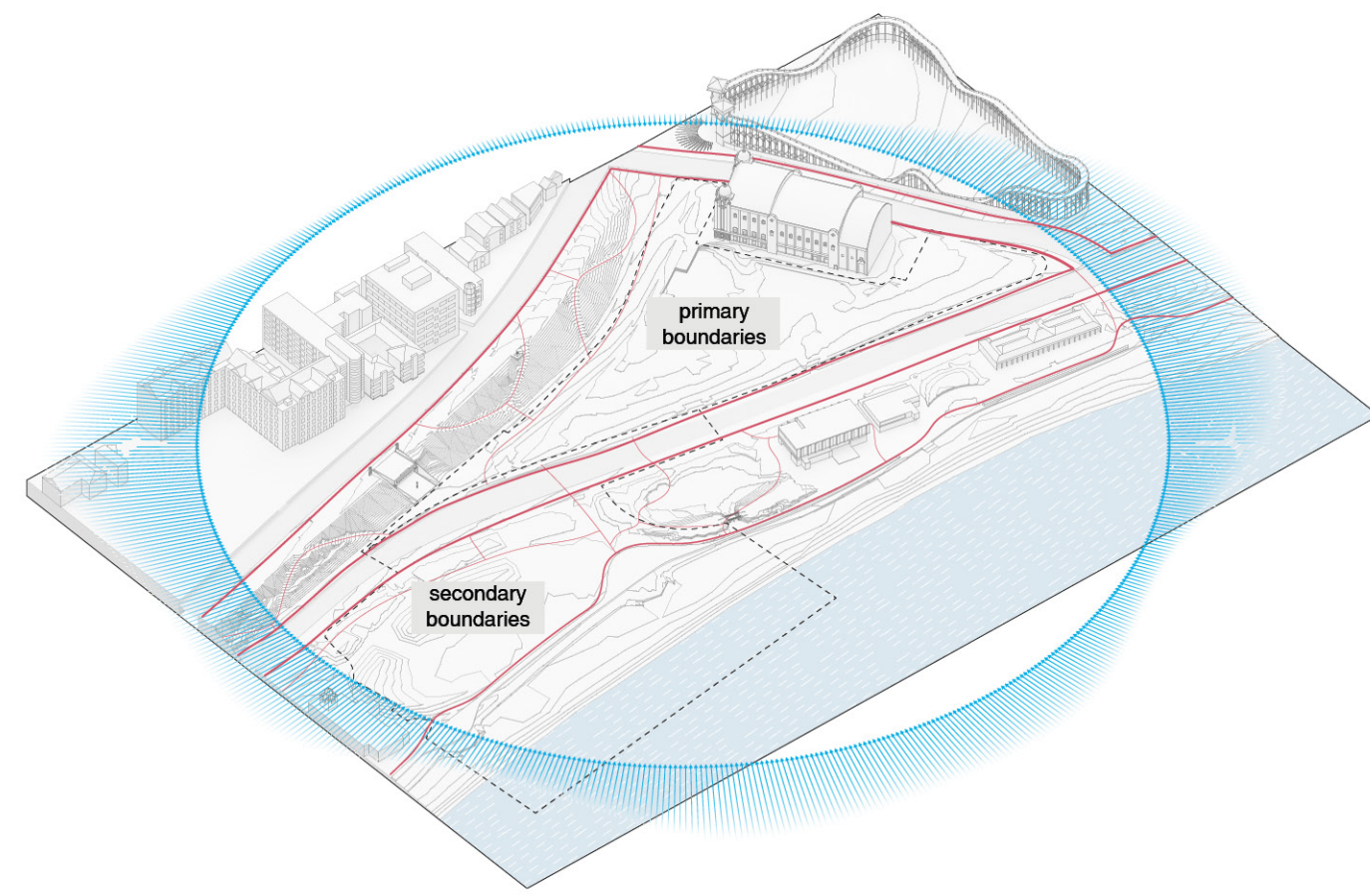
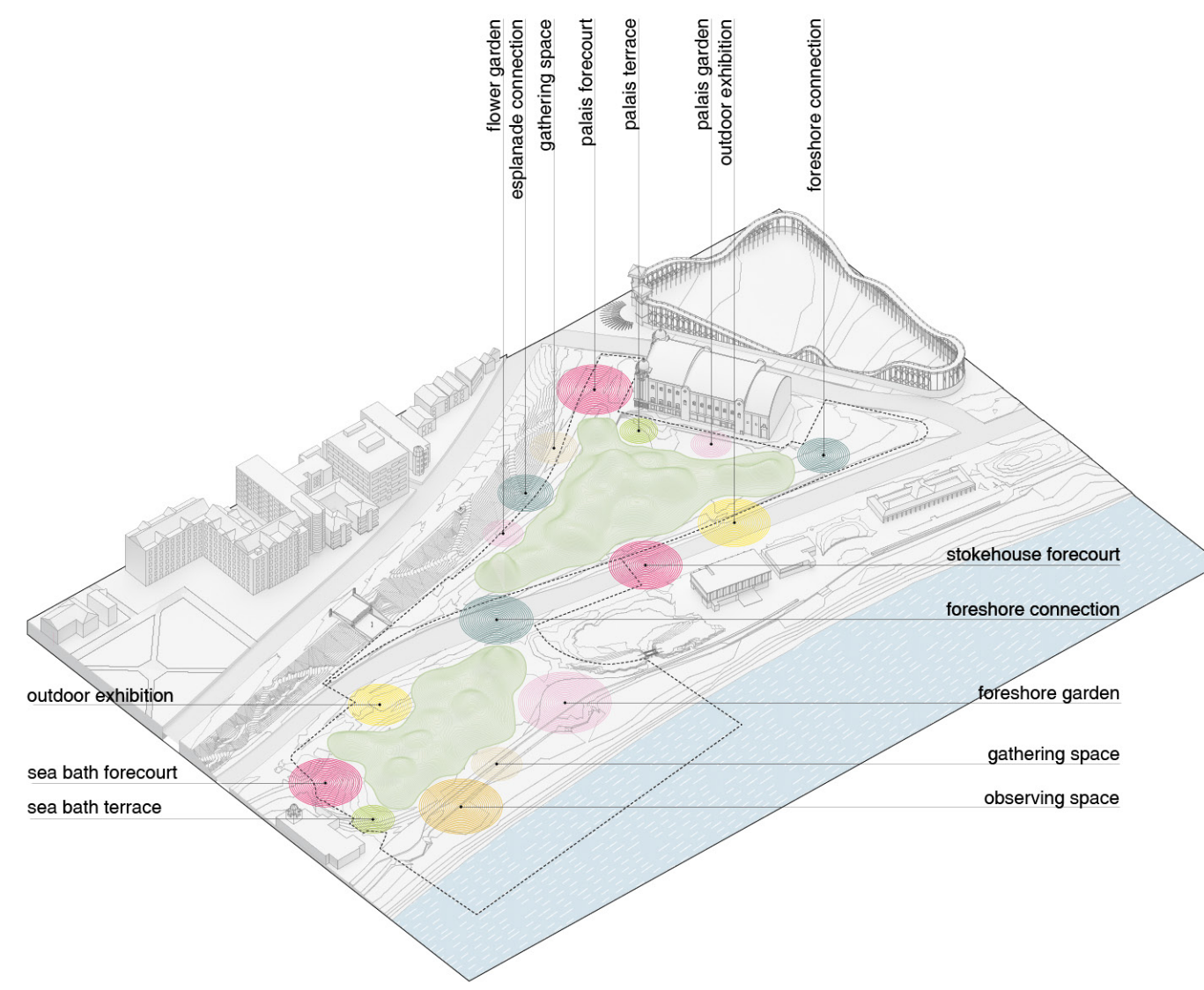


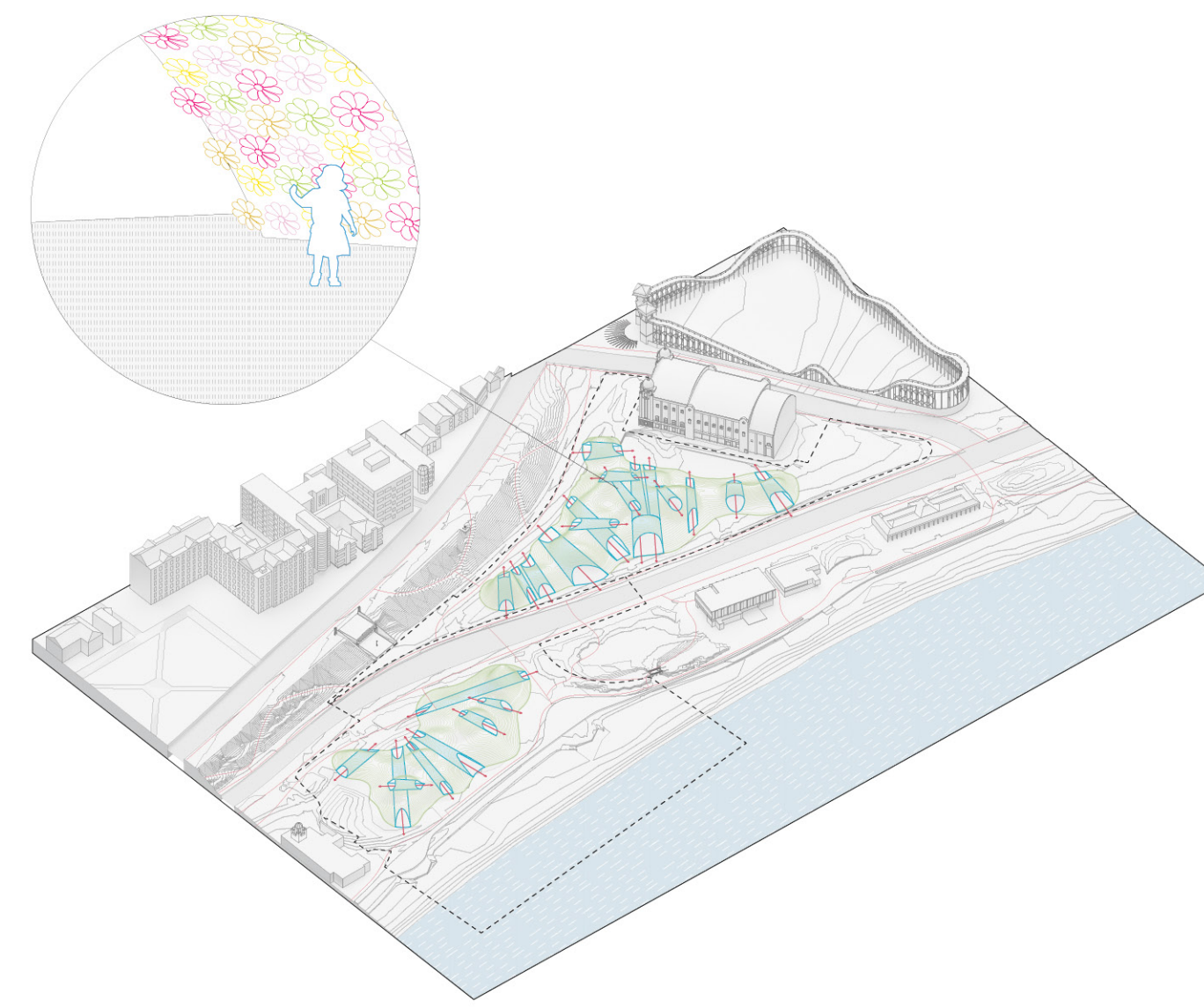
# Wind Blossom



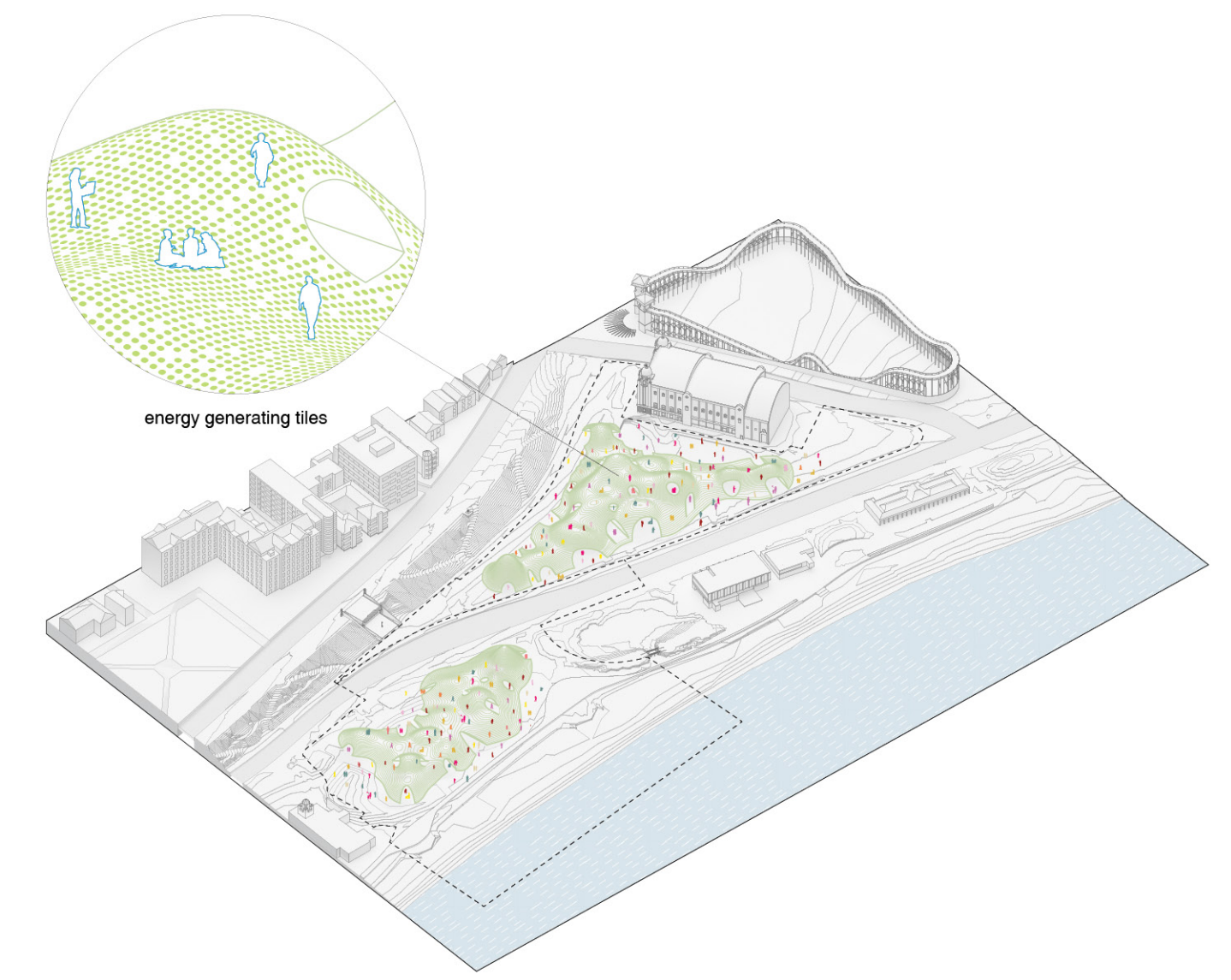
The environmental and urban conditions around St. Kilda Triangle are distinctive in terms of various flows of the people and the nature.
