


Inter-weave

St. Kilda acts as a node to the surrounding that draws residents and visitors to enjoy the beach and the sun. People get to enjoy a day of fun under the sun, frolicking around the water edge, sun tanning on the beach or even outside their homes along the Jacka Boulevard and the Esplanade. The sun acts as a catalyst for St. Kilda which attracts visitors and residents to the site and its surrounding. The new St. Kilda triangle intends to interweave the liveliness and the suburban culture of St Kilda by extending the principal landscapes from the edges of the site. The extension of the sand pattern from the foreshore creates earth mounds that protrudes from the ground level. This pulls in the lively atmosphere into the space while the sense of nature that stretches in from the upper level. The overlapping planes on the site blends the programs closely together help create a culture for St. Kilda.
