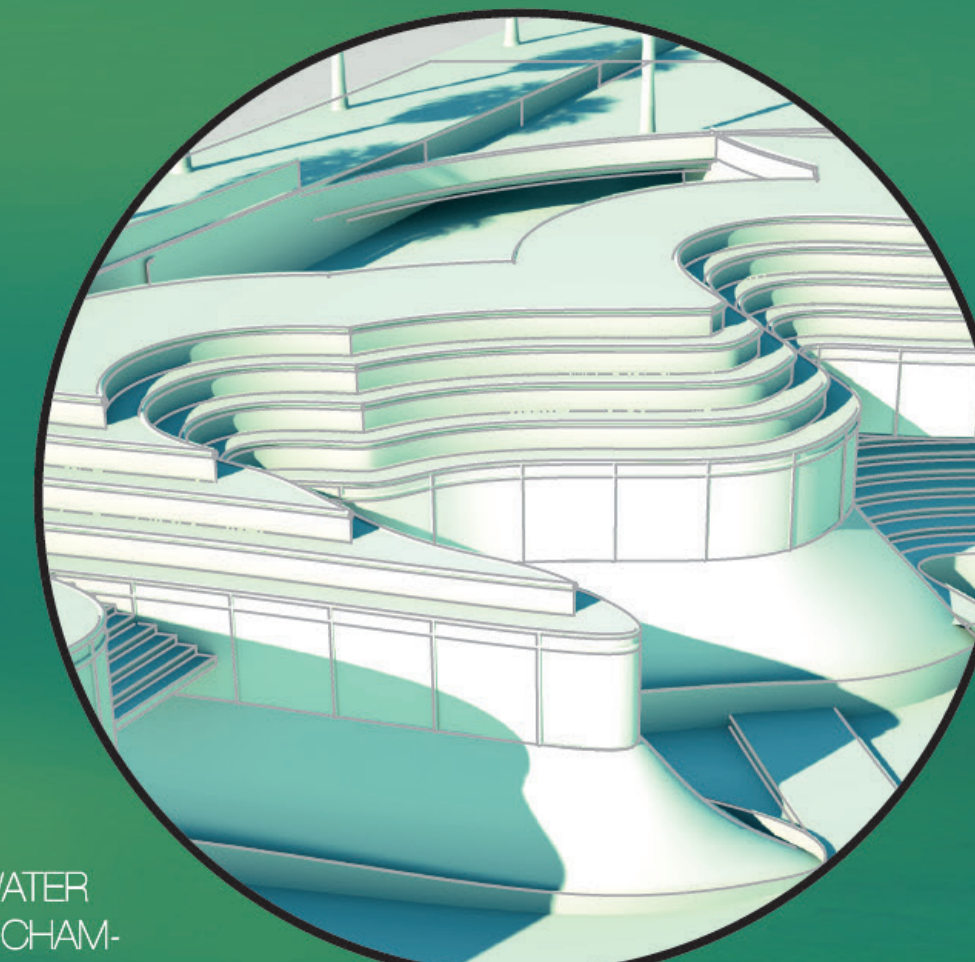
THE HOTEL FACADE COLLECTS
