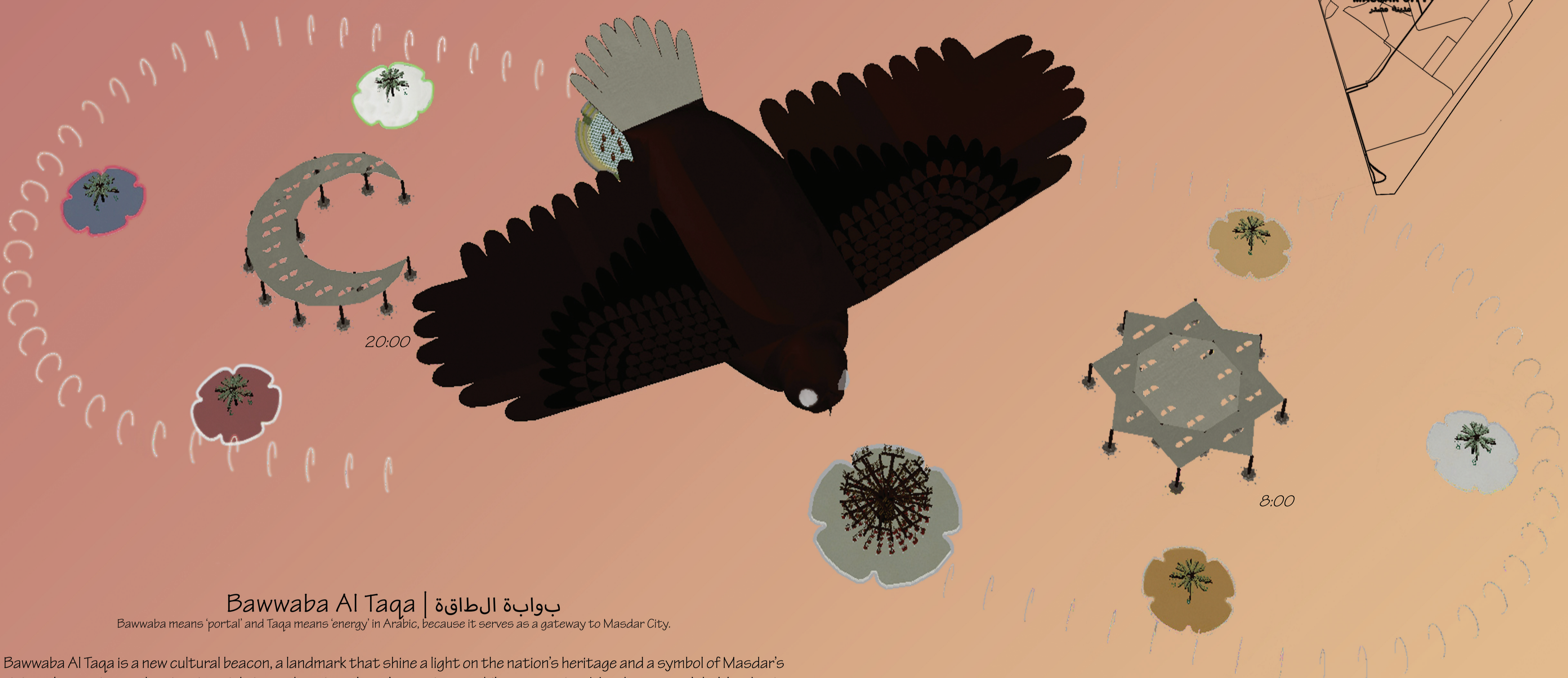


Harnessing cultural heritage...



Bawwaba Al Taqa | بوابة الطاقة

Bawwaba means 'portal' and Taqa means 'energy' in Arabic, because it serves as a gateway to Masdar City.

Bawwaba Al Taqa is a new cultural beacon, a landmark that shine a light on the nation's heritage and a symbol of Masdar's vision. A prominent destination rich in authentic cultural experience while supporting Masdar as a global leader in renewable energy and sustainable urban development.

This open space is inspired by nature and the nation's symbols and culture such as the falcon, ghaf tree, tribulus flower and the traditional Al-Sadu weaving technique. The main element used is copper which peacefully coexist with its surrounding so as to create an integrated space. This metallic colour is accented by palettes of red, green, white and black which represents the colour of UAE flag.
