Ghaf tree (Prosopis cineraria)

- slow-growing small tree of height 3-5 m
- drought-tolerant thanks to very deep roots, which can reach underground water,
- unavailable to most other plants and animals
- resistant to heat and cold (from 0°C up to 50°C)
- able to grow in a range of soils from sandy loam to clay loam providing highly nutritious fodder (can be cut for feed once a year or every two years in drier areas)
