Masi Siga Garden









Masi Siga Garden is shaped by the square grid and radial symmetry of traditional Fijian masi. At its center is a flexible shelter for gathering, talking, resting, or holding workshops. It is a space grounded in community values.

The canopy is made from traditional woven matting, thatching, or Masi-inspired printed cloth to create an authentic, culturally informed design. Surrounding the shelter are tropical garden beds, custom solar panels, rainwater catchment areas, and covered walkways. All elements work together within the Masi-inspired layout.

Built with low-impact, cyclone-resistant materials, the design is easy to maintain and supports clean energy and simple water systems. It responds to Fiji's climate challenges while strengthening local identity. This is not just a sustainable design. It is one that grows with the community and carries tradition forward.
