The concept is grounded in the real needs of the local community, with a strong focus on feasibility and long-term resilience.

Marou is a small village located in the Yasawa Islands, part of the Fiji archipelago. The village is made up of a small community of just 67 households, who face significant challenges due to the island's harsh weather conditions.

Beyond energy production, the community has other needs, such as public spaces, agricultural development, shaded educational infrastructure, and shelters against severe storms. Family, community, and respect for nature are central values in daily life, upheld by iTaukei traditions such as the Kava ceremony and the Meke dance.
