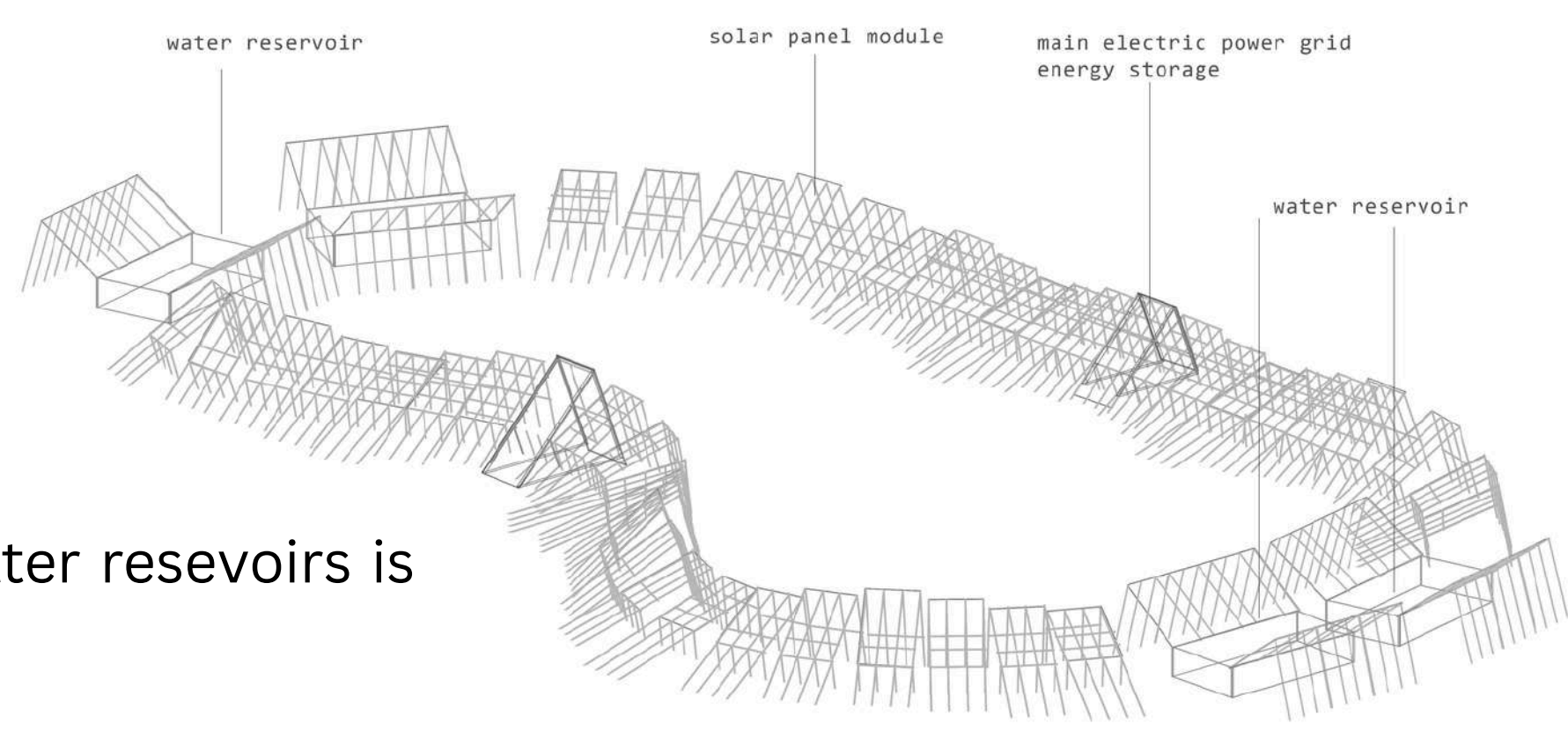


Concept

This installation-based project was designed for passive use, with its primary purpose being to support solar panel placement.

The placement of the modules and water resevoirs is one of many options valami valami

We intentionally left the area underneath the structure open to interpretation, allowing the local community to shape its use according to their needs. Rather than prescribing a fixed function, we see the project as an adaptable framework that can evolve over time.



Future

We hope that in the future, this space will be used in a way that allows visiting tourists to connect more deeply with the local people and their traditions. One example is the craft of mat weaving, a significant cultural practice in the village, which could be shared and displayed here.

The installation is also suitable for displaying locally made mats or textiles, which can be hung from structural elements designed for this purpose.

Our concept draws inspiration from land art — a subtle intervention in the landscape. Bringing solar energy systems closer to people offers a pathway toward greater understanding of energy use and its underlying processes.
