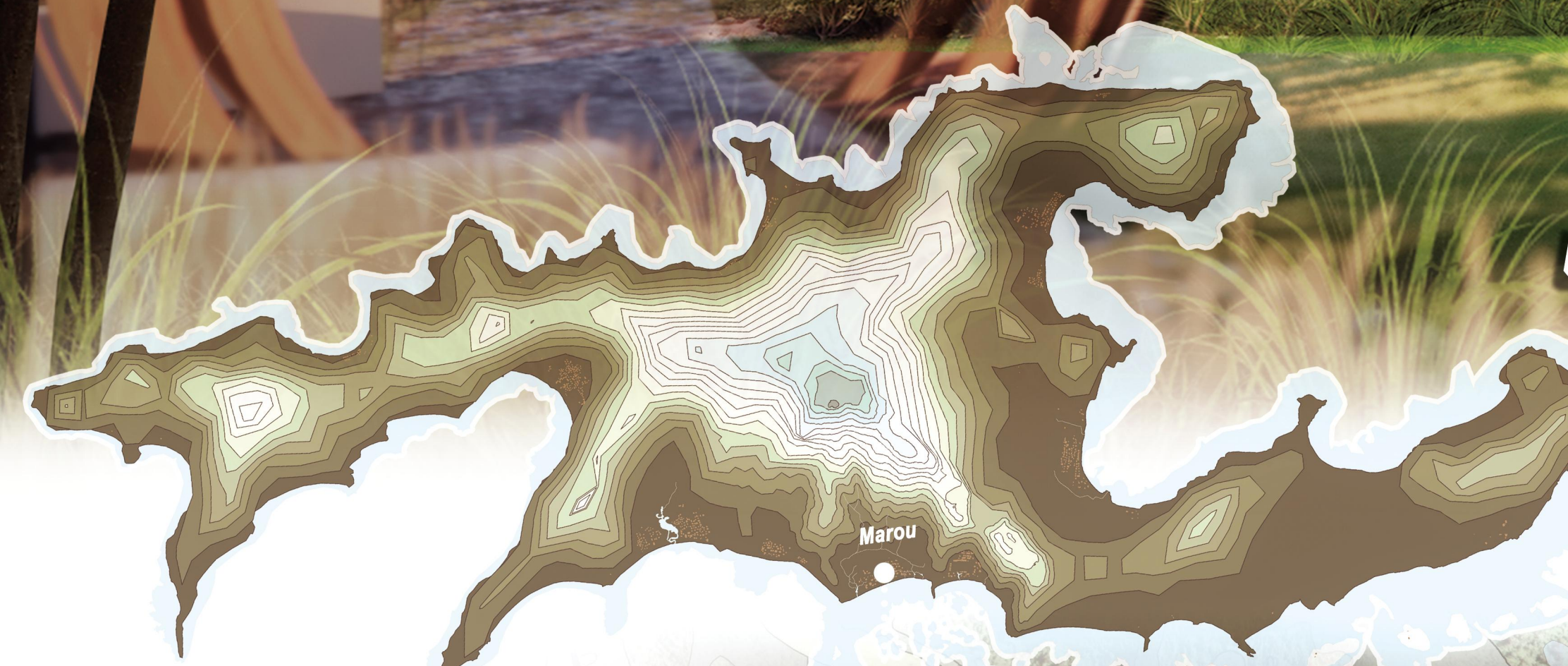




# The Eye of Naviti
