

Loma Shade

By delivering renewable energy and rainwater harvesting, it directly supports essential services such as lighting, refrigeration, water access while surpassing carbon-heavy alternatives. Yet, its impact reaches far beyond infrastructure.

As a public space, the Luma Shade fosters community gathering, intergenerational exchange, and cultural education. "Under its wings" tourist and locals can learn about local tradition and see how old dynasty can combine with new technology. It strengthens the local community not only by offering clean energy and water, but by building local skills and pride.
