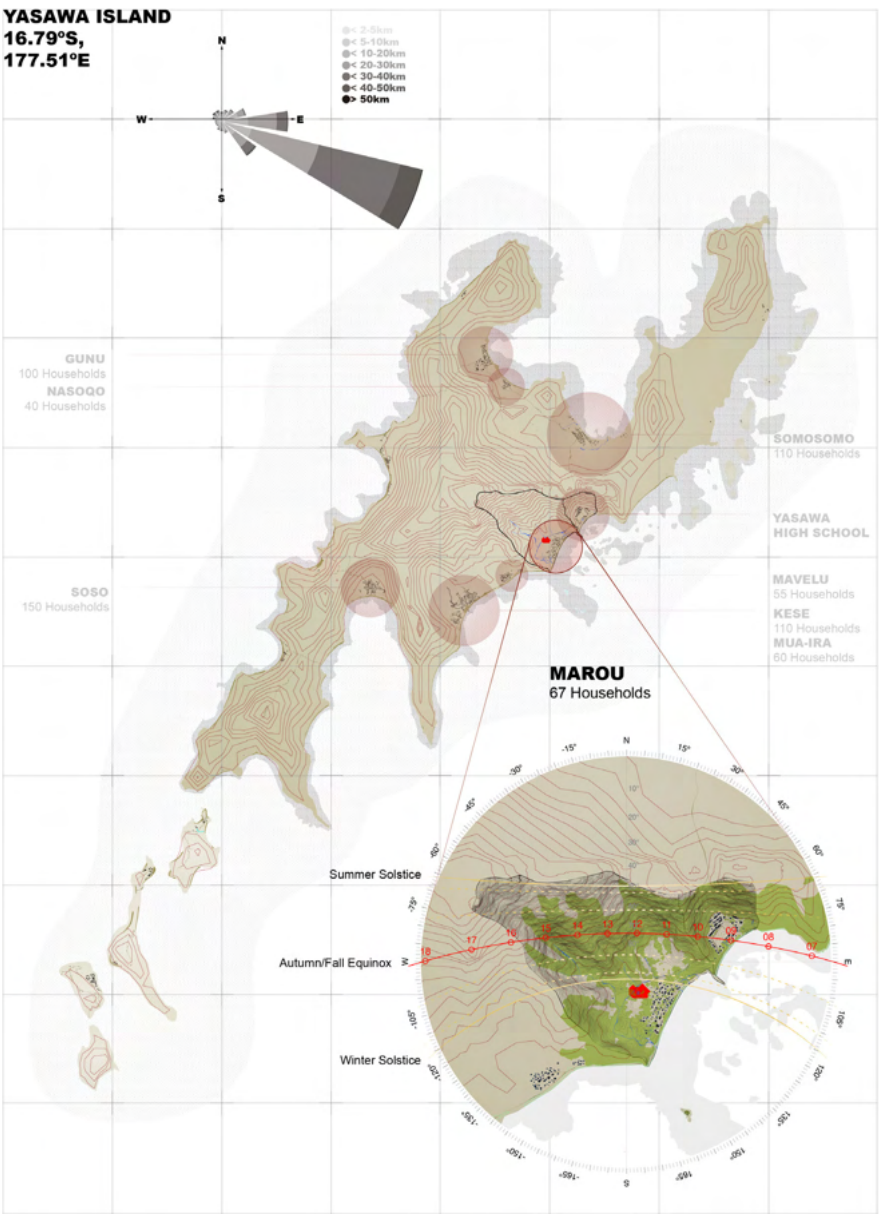
PROJECT GOALS

Planting of shade trees in groves can be used for various programmes: outdoor classrooms, market sites and community gathering spaces.

The island's location and nature, coupled with the ever-growing threats from climate change, could position the Marou community as a leader in self-sustaining and resilient systems that are essential to meeting the long-term needs of High Island communities everywhere.

The array is storm protected using a simple tap which submerges the panels with water from the adjacent catchment pond.



Our system and installation can easily be adapted for other potential/similar locations utilising high Island water sheds , both in coast and in inland communities forming a series of pixelated artful energy/ water/cultural power plant zones throughout the islands that

free the Fijian economy from the burden of oil.
