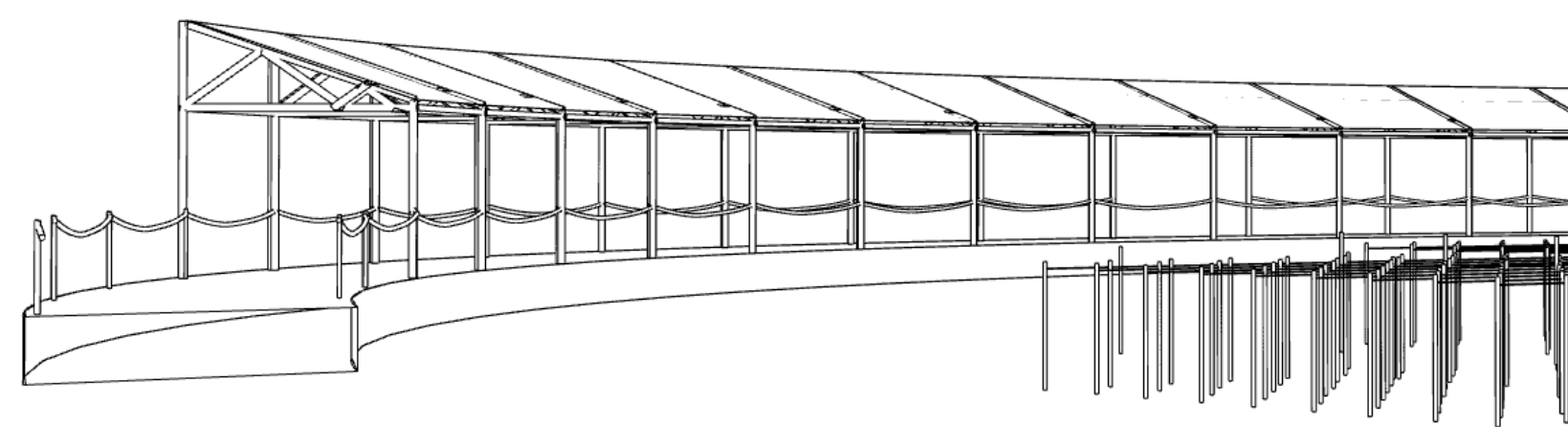




A RESILIENT SHORELINE FOR A RESILIENT FIJI



At the shoreline, we have created a dock where people from neighboring villages (and islands) can come and access both drinking water and electricity to charge devices on their boats. Within the dock structure we are creating, we will have a nursery for shoreline-stabilizing mangrove trees, which have been recommended for use by the Fijian government as a strategy to prevent erosion in vulnerable coastal areas.

Across the site - solar energy is captured, so if one mechanism is damaged at the community center or the dock, the other system will still be able to function in the interim. Creating additional industry in the village via agricultural cultivation increases the resiliency of the community in the changing times on the island, and creates access to the changing shoreline.
