The project is based on the principles of sustainability: the use of natural materials, the revival of crafts, the preservation of oral traditions and communal farming. As in the past, there is no place for excessive consumption here — every element of

architecture reminds that a person is a part of the whole. The village of Maru has become not just a symbol of cultural heritage, but a living laboratory where the past and present merge, proving that the wisdom of the islanders, their ability to live in balance with the ocean and the jungle, is relevant even in the modern world.
