In the enchanting setting of the Fiji Islands, immersed in the lush nature of the island of Naviti, a land art project comes to life that fuses aesthetics, functionality and sustainability. The Smile of Fiji. Located within the village of Marou, this architectural intervention represents a perfect balance between innovation and respect for the context, following the principles of "Genius Loci". Its most fascinating peculiarity is the changing perception it offers visitors and villagers. From the ground perspective, it appears as a gentle green hill, in perfect continuity with the surrounding natural landscape. Mimesis, sustainability and modularity are the main themes. Through the dialogue between nature and architecture, this land art project is not only an aesthetic work, but a concrete contribution to the quality of life of the inhabitants of Marou, a model of sustainable development that enhances the territory and its people.
