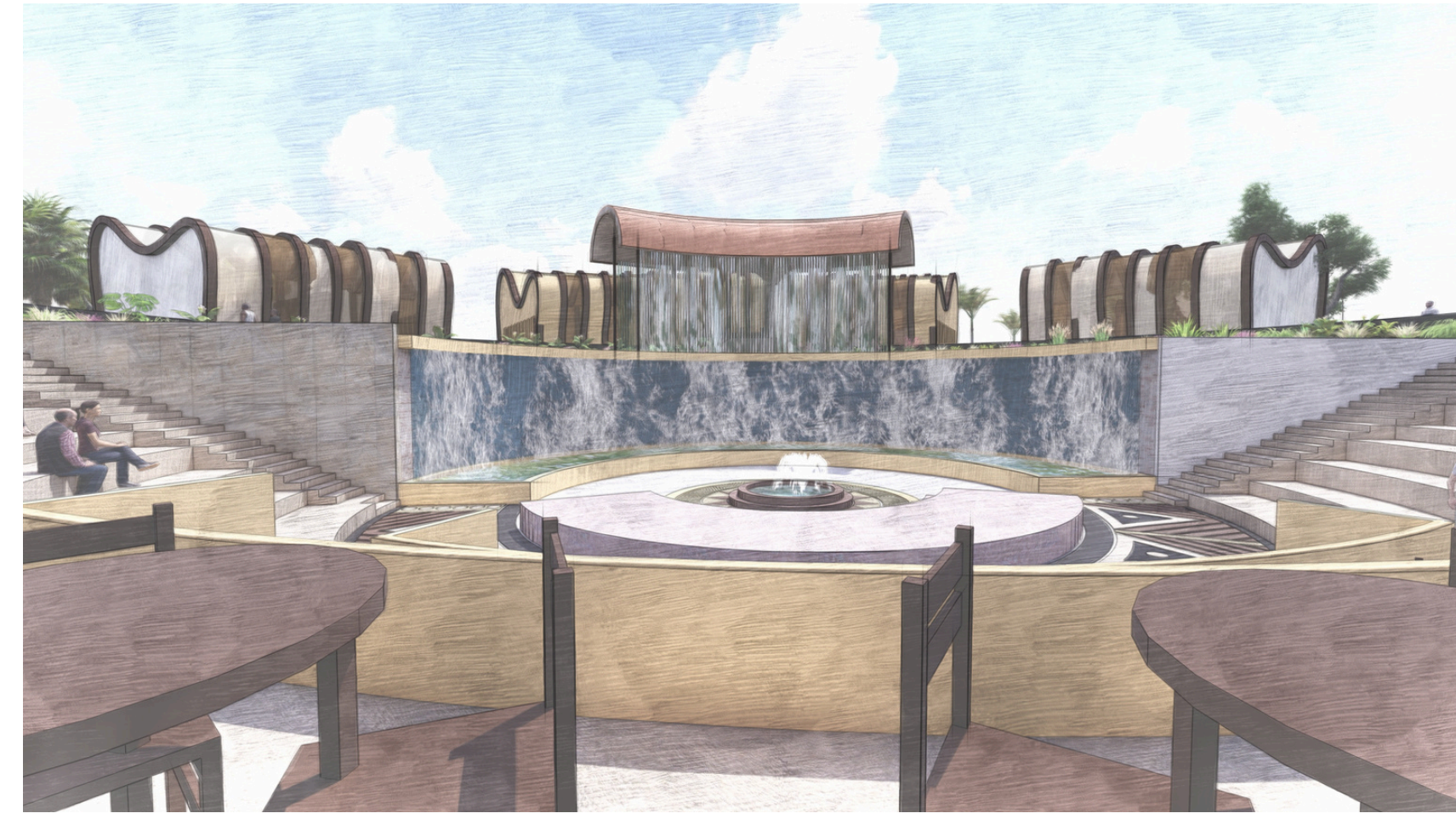
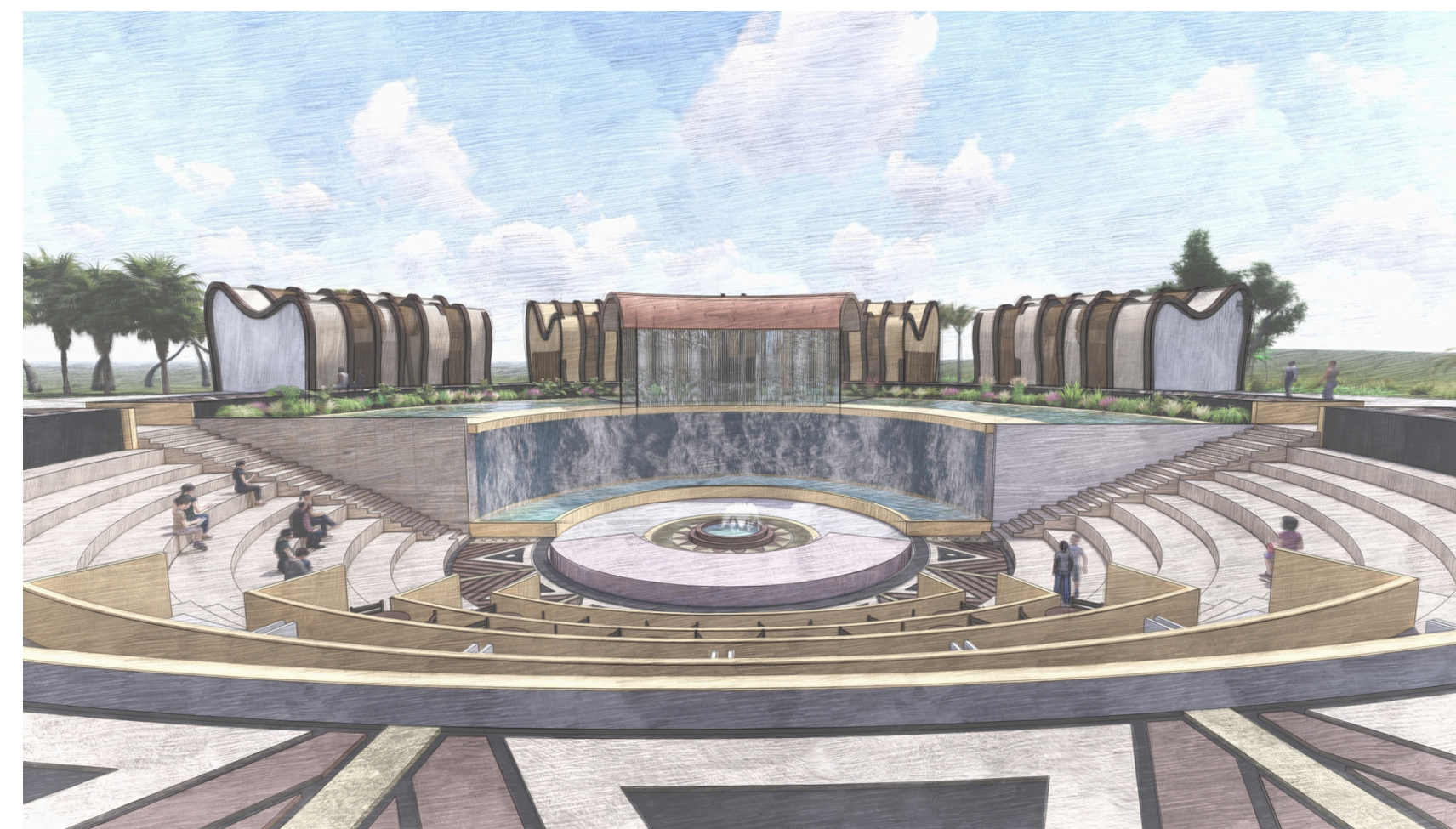


CONCEPTUAL DESIGN & SPATIAL PLANNING

The stage in the middle of the bowl is surrounded by beautiful views of a water fall flowing at the back wall of the tank that hosts water underneath.



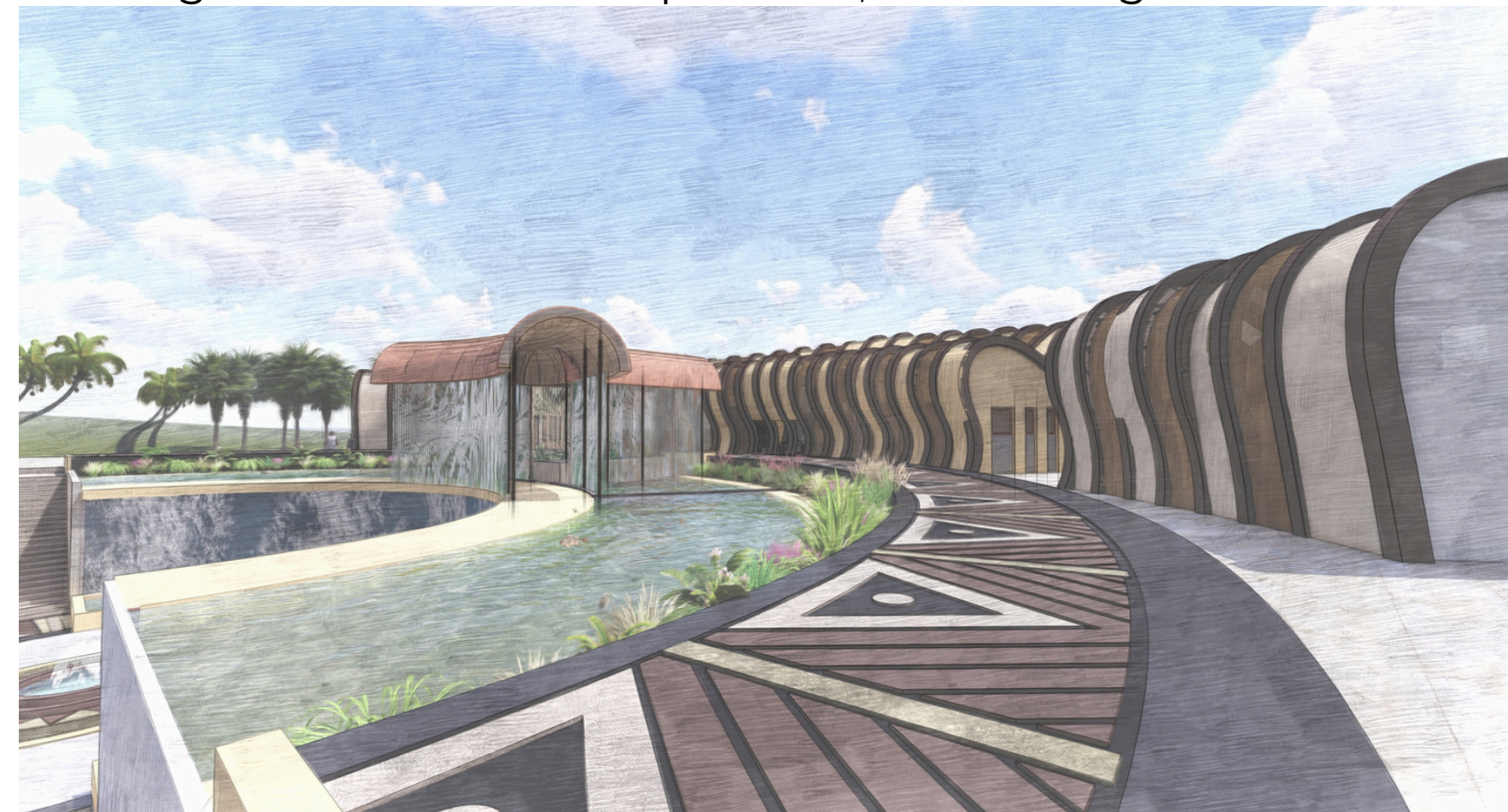
View of what the "Kava bowl" looks like from the edge, looking into it.

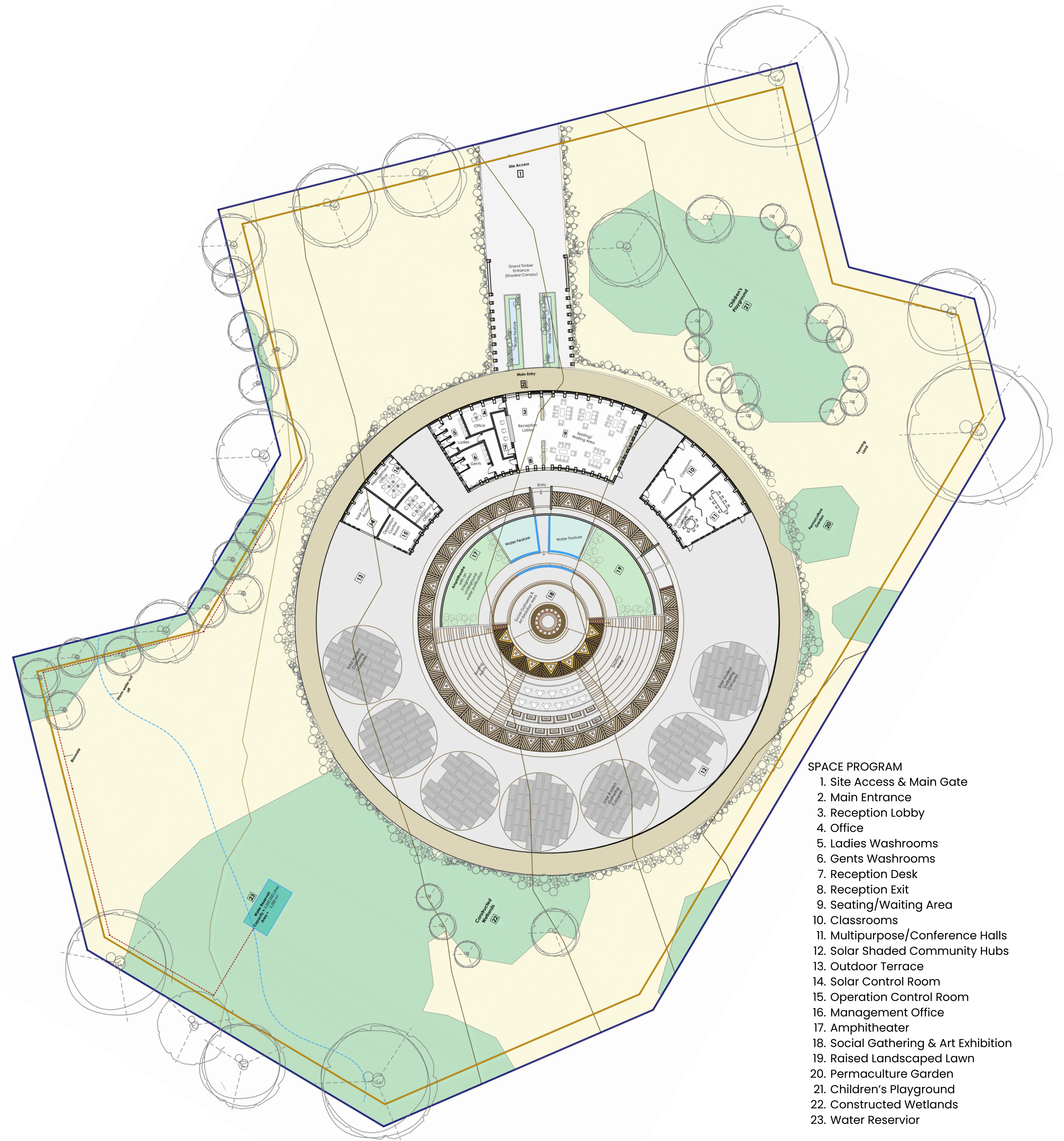

Image of what it's like literally inside the "Kava bowl" on the far end from the front, we have the shaded pavilion area that is inspired by the Kava leaf design. These structures act as solar shading, they host the solar panels above, as well as act as rain water catchment, harvesting water and leading it to underground water tank.



The top of the "Kava bowl" has Fijian traditional patterns, grounding the project to its unique cultural identity.
