### AMPHITHEATER

THE AMPHITHEATRE IS A MULTIFUNCTIONAL PUBLIC SPACE THAT SERVES BOTH TOURISTS AND LOCALS. THE AMPHITHEATRE OFTEN BECOMES A VENUE FOR CULTURAL EVENTS. THIS HELPS TO PRESERVE AND POPULARISE FIJIAN CULTURE. IT HOSTS VARIOUS EDUCATIONAL EVENTS AND EXHIBITIONS THAT EDUCATE GUESTS ABOUT FIJI'S HISTORY AND TRADITIONS, AS WELL AS ITS NATURAL TREASURES.

THE AMPHITHEATRE ALSO PROVIDES AN OPPORTUNITY FOR LOCALS AND TOURISTS TO COME TOGETHER, SHARE EXPERIENCES AND MAKE NEW ACQUAINTANCES, WHICH HELPS TO STRENGTHEN THE COMMUNITY.

THIS NOT ONLY ENRICHES LEISURE TIME BUT ALSO ENCOURAGES INTERACTION BETWEEN CULTURES, CREATING A UNIQUE ATMOSPHERE FOR ALL VISITORS.



### THE STAGE SPACE

DANCE IN FIJI IS INDEED AN IMPORTANT CULTURAL ELEMENT AND A SELF-VALUED PART OF LOCAL LIFE. THE STAGE SPACE CREATED FOR THIS PURPOSE FULFILLS SEVERAL IMPORTANT FUNCTIONS:

1. PRESERVING TRADITIONS: ON STAGE, THE PEOPLE OF FIJI CAN SHOWCASE THEIR UNIQUE DANCES AND CHOREOGRAPHIES, ALLOWING NEW GENERATIONS TO PRESERVE AND PASS ON THEIR CULTURAL HERITAGE.
2. TOURIST ATTRACTION: ORGANISING PERFORMANCES AND FESTIVALS IN PURPOSE-BUILT SPACES HELPS TO ATTRACT TOURISTS, WHICH HELPS TO BOOST THE ECONOMY OF THE REGION.
3. CULTURAL EXCHANGE: THESE VENUES BECOME PLATFORMS FOR DIALOGUE BETWEEN CULTURES, WHERE LOCALS CAN SHARE THEIR TRADITIONS WITH VISITORS AND TOURISTS IN TURN CAN LEARN MORE ABOUT FIJI'S RICH CULTURAL HERITAGE.
4. SOCIAL COHESION: STAGE PERFORMANCES BRING THE COMMUNITY TOGETHER, STRENGTHENING BONDS BETWEEN RESIDENTS AND MAINTAINING A SPIRIT OF UNITY.



### HYDROPONICS

IT REDUCES THE AMOUNT OF RESOURCES USED, SUCH AS WATER AND FERTILISER, MINIMISES SOIL DISTURBANCE AND PROMOTES MORE EFFICIENT FOOD PRODUCTION IN LAND-LIMITED ENVIRONMENTS. HYDROPONICS ALLOWS THE CULTIVATION OF ROOT CROPS SUCH AS CASSAVA, CASSAVA HIBISCUS, AND VARIOUS TYPES OF HERBS AND FLOWERS. HYDROPONICS OPENS UP NEW POSSIBILITIES FOR DIVERSITY AND OPTIMISATION OF AGRICULTURE, ESPECIALLY IN THE TROPICAL CONDITIONS OF FIJI.



### PAVILIONS

PAVILIONS ARE SPACES THAT PROMOTE THE PRESERVATION AND DISSEMINATION OF LOCAL TRADITIONS. HERE ARE A FEW KEY ASPECTS OF THESE PAVILIONS:

1. CULINARY MASTERCLASSES: GUESTS ARE OFFERED THE OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN HOW TO COOK TRADITIONAL FIJIAN DISHES: KAKONDA, ROTI OR CASSAVA. THIS NOT ONLY ENRICHES THEIR GASTRONOMIC EXPERIENCE, BUT ALSO GIVES THEM AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE LOCAL CULTURE AND COOKING METHODS.
2. CRAFT COURSES: HERE YOU CAN LEARN TRADITIONAL FIJIAN CRAFTS SUCH AS WEAVING PALM LEAF MATS OR WOOD CARVING. THESE CLASSES HELP PRESERVE ANCIENT TECHNIQUES AND SUPPORT LOCAL ARTISANS.
3. TEA CEREMONIES: WITHIN THE PAVILIONS, TEA CEREMONIES WITH THE TRADITIONAL KAVA DRINK ARE HELD, WHICH ARE NOT ONLY A DELICIOUS EXPERIENCE BUT ALSO AN OPPORTUNITY TO GAIN A DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF FIJIAN CUSTOMS AND TRADITIONS.
