









Central to the architectural language is a tensile canopy system designed with intentional impermanence. Lightweight membranes are engineered to disengage or collapse under extreme weather, minimizing structural damage and

Vertical supports are fitted with modular brackets and clearly marked anchor points, allowing villagers to reassemble or reconfigure the canopies as needed. This system transforms weather events into opportunities for creative renewal. Each reconstruction introduces new rhythms, new geometries—allowing the built environment to evolve with its people, its seasons, and its climate.
