

# SEA WHAT HAPPENS

*'The Man and the Old Sea'. A work of changing volumes and transparencies, for a heartfelt appeal: because saving the life of the ocean means saving the life of man on earth.*

*Waves - source of art and beauty*

A healthy ocean is vital for the entire global ecosystem; for the inhabitants of the Fiji Islands, it takes on an additional dimension of daily urgency, representing a fundamental presence not only for health, but also as a symbol of history and culture.

'SOLAR WAVES' are an ideal symbol of the cultural identity of the village of Marou, representing both its vital dependence on the ocean and its vulnerability to its powerful forces.

'SOLAR WAVES' have a white metal structure supporting a photovoltaic plane composed by panels with monocrystalline silicon photovoltaic cells with a custom lamination of high-transmittance white nano-film. The artworks can have three different inclinations on the horizontal plane, depending on the energy needs at different hours of the day: 19° for the PV array facing north and 30° and 40° for the modules facing east or west.
