Influenced by the culture and way of life of the Numu people (Northern Paiute), the stewards of the Nevada and Fly Ranch, we envisioned a shelter that reconciles the past and future, that honors the traditions of the Numu and adapts to the future

The Paiute, living a nomadic lifestyle, built movable shelters. Inspired by their shelter, the wickiup, our modules were designed to offer both flexibility and adaptability in a shape that grows from the ground and blends into the existing landscape.

The nomadic Numu gathered annually to celebrate the harvest. In a similar fashion, in our futuristic vision, we designed three communities with specific interests and activities, connected through different pathways, gathering frequently in a designat-






3D TESSELATIONS 3D TESSELATIONS using different triangles to aggregate into various components


