



Bird Hive is strategically located adjacent to the BUGA gardens in an effort to enhance the experience of nature and green space in Spinelli Park through habitation by local fauna. Hugging a primary circulation path, splitting the gardens from the open fields, Bird Hive invites passerby to pause, look, and listen. Occupied nesting platforms in each "flower" provide opportunity to witness and learn about local bird species. Visitors can begin to learn about some of their smaller neighbors and how to identify them by both sight and sound as they navigate through this green corridor.

Bird Hive is also carefully located in relation to the climatic conditions of the site. It is set along the north-south axis to take advantage of the predominant winds coming out of the south. This also allows it to gather light from morning to afternoon while orienting it towards the gardens for direct access by occupying birds.
