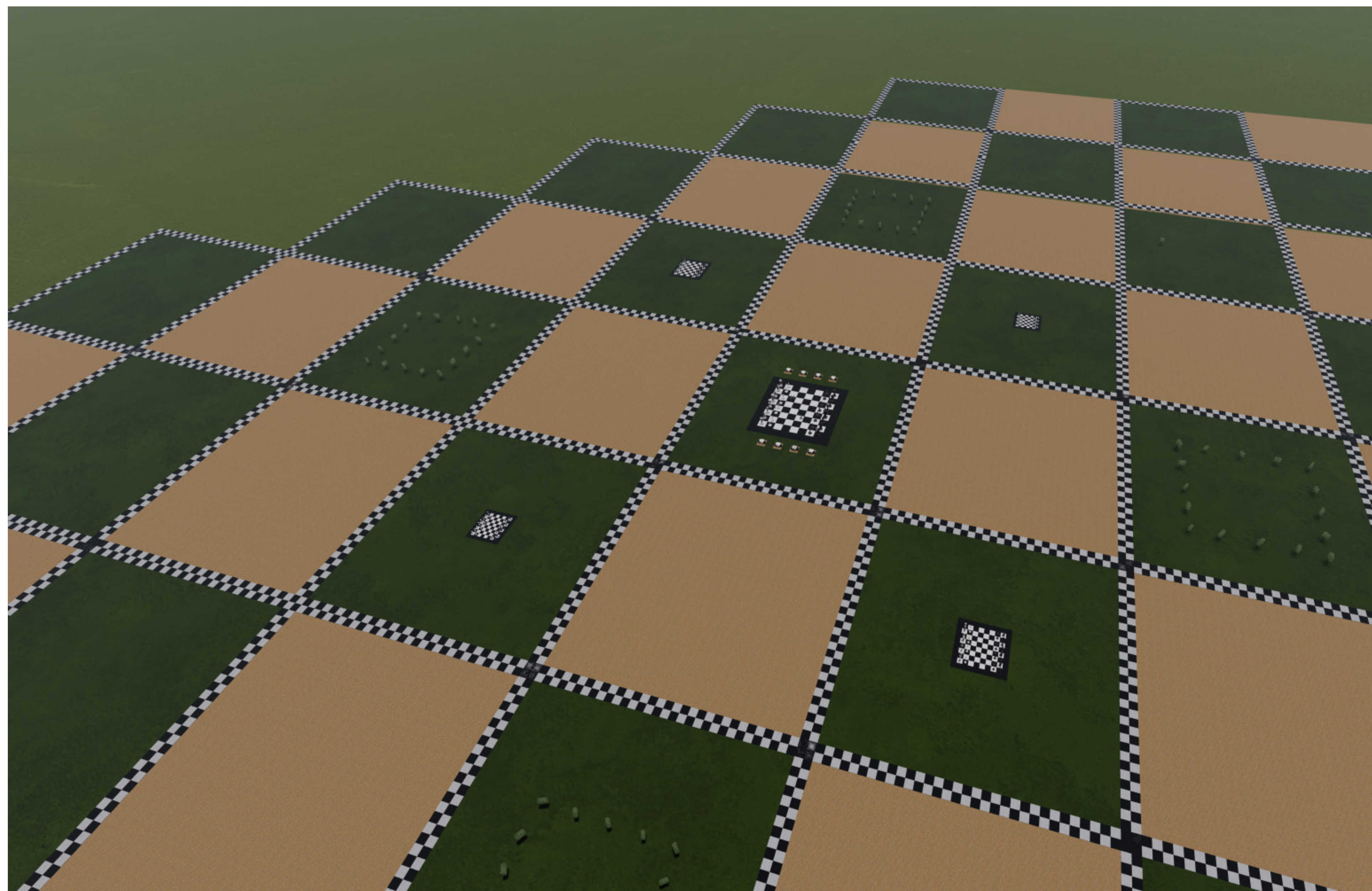


GARDEN OF CHAMPIONS
