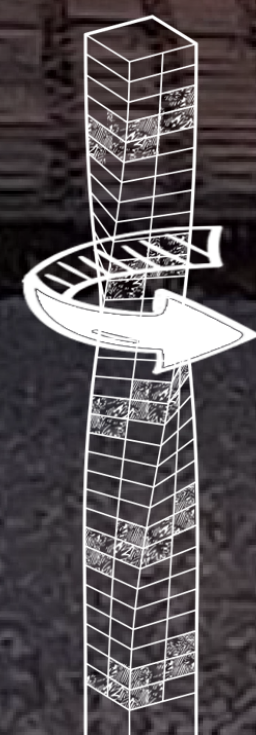


Light the Streets

The project is broken down into various scales through a simple twisting motion - using the same façade applied for different uses. At the pedestrian level, the landmark monument transforms to an elegant self-sufficient streetlamp, where the energy generated by LSC panels during the day illuminates the street at night. Alternating with the LSC panels are lattices of the green climbing plants, transforming what was once just a streetlamp into a vertical planter. These streetlamps, arrayed towards the Spinelli Pillar - provide a wayfinding path to the main obelisk - yet also serve as a spiritual guide, constantly reminding us the possibilities of clean energy.

In the Garden

Further twisting the streetlamp - we transform into the home gardening trellis. These small product-like structures sit in each individual Scherbergarten - generating power for gardening tools and doubling as an aid for growing plants. At night, each individual trellis lights up in various colors, giving everyone their own piece of the Spinelli Pillar.
