





ONE OF THE MAIN GOALS OF THE PLAN AND THE GRAND GOALS IN MANHEIM'S URBAN DEVELOPMENT IS TO CREATE A MIDDLE GREEN STRIP IN THE ALMOST NORTH-SOUTH AXIS IN THE CITY. THEREFORE, AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE, THIS DECISION SHOULD REMAIN IN THE PLAN. VEGETATION IN THE SITE AND PLAN IS DIVIDED INTO FOUR SECTIONS AND MAIN ZONES;
