

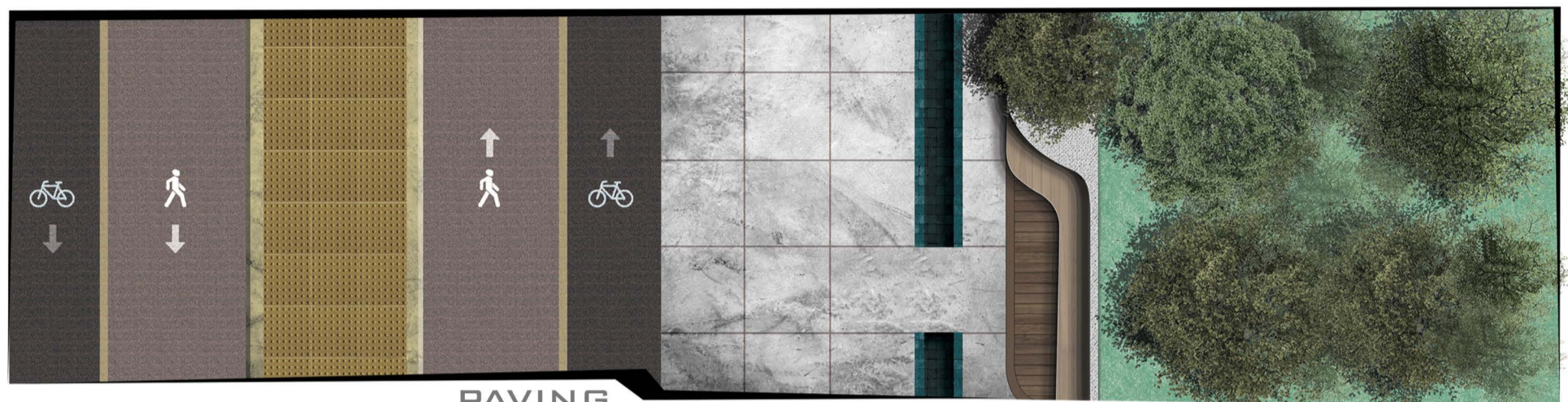
SITE AND LIFE LAY OUT

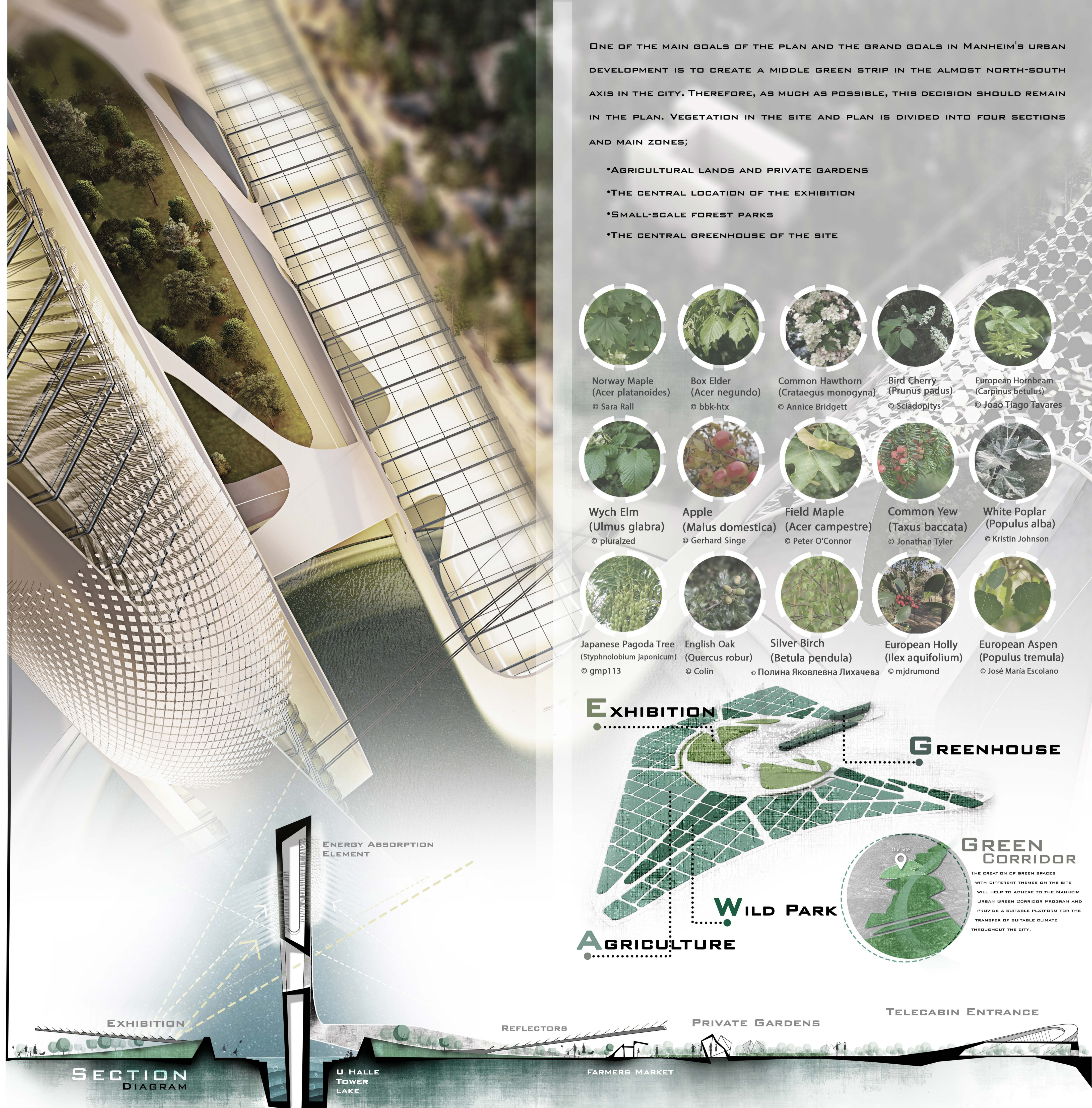
